

Risk Mitigation and Event Protocols

To provide a safe, and healthy event the following protocols have been implemented. Please commit to the common good! Please note these protocols may change with changing executive orders and state mandates.

1. Health & Safety

1.1. Face Coverings/Masks/Eye Protection:

- 1.1.1. Face Coverings/Masks are required for all persons in attendance.
- 1.1.2. Please stay home if you have health issues preventing you from wearing a mask.
- 1.1.3. Please stay home if you or anyone in your household are experiencing symptoms of illness.
- 1.1.4. Eye Protection is recommended but is not required,
- 1.1.5. The following Mask Exceptions will apply:
 - 1.1.5.1. Face Coverings/Masks are not required while in your designated safe area/bubble.
 - 1.1.5.2. Face coverings/masks are not required after you exit the starting chute and while participating on the race trail. However, face coverings/masks are required prior to re-entering the dog yard.
 - 1.1.5.3. Face Coverings/Masks are not required when eating or drinking in designated areas while maintaining (at a minimum) a 6-foot distance.

2. Communal Space Risk Mitigation

- 2.1. All persons will comply with posted requirements.
- 2.2. Maintain a minimum 6-foot distance from those not in your bubble.

3. Race Participants

- 3.1. Participants are expected to come prepared to be independent. This includes but is not limited to, equipment, tools, gear, replacement parts, dog food & water. Sharing between participants is not recommended and will be discouraged.
- 3.2. Race bibs
 - 3.2.1. Bib numbers will be determined in advance.
 - 3.2.2. Participant packets containing your race bib and other essential information will be provided prior to entering the dog yard.
 - 3.2.2.1. Participants should be prepared to stop and mask at or near the dog yard entrance. A volunteer will approach your vehicle, gather your information, and provide the corresponding participant packet.
 - 3.2.2.2. If designated parking is implemented your parking number will be given to you at this time.
 - 3.2.3. Race Bib Return.
 - 3.2.3.1. It is the participants responsibility to turn in their bib.
 - 3.2.3.2. The participant should be prepared to show the volunteer the bib number and state their name. The volunteer will confirm the information and note the

bib as received. Once confirmed the participant can drop the bib into the designated area.

3.3. Dog Yard

- 3.3.1. Spectators are not permitted in the dog yard.
- 3.3.2. Open trash/recycling can(s)/bin(s) will be made available. Please use them for their intended purpose.
- 3.3.3. Mushers are responsible for their designated area. Please maintain a clean and safe environment.
- 3.3.4. Dog feces cleanup and disposal. We do not provide this service. Do not leave it behind. Do not throw it in the trash.

4. Healthy Hygiene

- 4.1. Hand Sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol will be made available to the public.
- 4.2. Public Restroom(s)/Portable toilet(s) will be available for public use.
 - 4.2.1. Portable toilet(s) shall contain hand sanitizer for public use.
 - 4.2.2. The Portable toilet(s) will be disinfected periodically. In addition, users should disinfect touch areas before and after use to prevent the spread of any viruses.

5. Screening and Self Assessment

- 5.1. All participants will receive a self-assessment checklist to assess their health upon entering the premises.
- 5.2. All race participants and personnel will be screened for temperature.
- 5.3. Individuals or anyone in their immediate family (living in the same home) reporting the following symptom(s) will not be permitted into the race grounds or associated check points and will be asked to return home
 - 5.3.1. A fever (100.0 or higher) within the last 72 hours, A cough or sore throat, Shortness of breath, Chills; repeated shaking with chills, Muscle pain, not related to a prior condition, Headache, New loss of taste or smell, Direct household contact with a person experiencing an undiagnosed cough and fever, Unprotected contact with a known positive Covid19 individual, Diarrhea and/or vomiting within the last 24 hours
